



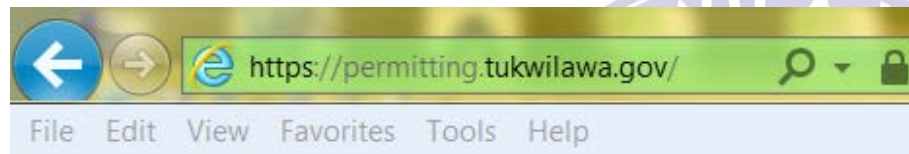

eTRAKiT Website

eTRAKiT allows you to view multiple items:

- **Permits:** search permit by permit number, address, parcel number, applicant or tenant name, owner name or permit type;
- **Projects:** search land use applications submitted through the planning department;
- **Contractors:** information on contractors, as well an architect or engineer;
- **Properties:** information about parcels, including permit history;
- **Inspections:** schedule, view and/or cancel inspections;
- **Violations:** information about current to closed code cases in Tukwila;
- **Citizen Input:** submit information to the city ranging from a general inquiry to graffiti, junk vehicles, construction debris in the city street due to a construction project and more.
