ESTABLISHING FORMAL AFFILIATION WITH IKAWA-CHO,

WHEREAS, said proposed City Affiliation is supported by the citizens and civic organizations of the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF TUKWILA, WASHINGTON, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, that formal affiliations are hereby created with Ikawa-Cho, Tokushima-Prefecture, Japan. Tukwila is honored to become the Sister City of Ikawa, to encourage the exchange of ideas, culture, and friendships, and to cooperate in other programs designed to facilitate the relationship between the two cities and to create better international understanding and good will between the citizens of the two cities.
