**DEVELOPMENT BULLETIN A5
TEMPORARY WATER METER**

The City rents water meters on a temporary, short-term basis for use on one designated project where a metered supply does not already exist. Examples include dust suppression during construction or hydroseeding.

The rental is subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary water meter is installed on fire hydrants only, using **ONLY** hydrant wrenches when connecting or disconnecting the meter. The renter is liable for all fire hydrant damage that occurs during installation or removal.
2. The meter is presented to Public Works Operations every 30 days for a meter reading and inspection.
3. The meter is promptly returned following project completion or by the permit expiration, whichever comes first. Renter receives a final bill when the meter is returned to Operations.
4. The meter is returned in the same condition as when rented. The renter is responsible for meter damage or loss and shall pay all costs related to repair or replacement.
5. The renter may move the meter(s) from one hydrant to another within the same project providing the Water Department is notified and approves the move before it occurs.

This Bulletin should not be used as a substitute for codes and regulations. Your project will be reviewed for specific compliance to codes and regulations.
